

Does Cost Sharing Reduce Waste?

Yes, but ...

RAND Health Insurance Experiment (HIE)

- Cost sharing reduced episodes of care
 - reduced episodes of ineffective treatment
 - and, reduced episodes of highly effective treatments

RAND Health Insurance Experiment (HIE)

- Cost sharing reduced emergency dept. visits
 - 47% reduction for less urgent problems
 - and, 23% reduction for more urgent problems

RAND Health Insurance Experiment (HIE)

 Any cost sharing (>\$0) more important than amount

Pharmaceuticals

- Cost sharing reduces use of essential drugs
 - increased emergency department visits and hospitalizations
 - →increases overall costs


Medicaid Expansions
